DO NOT FLUSH (DNF) LIST

Point O'Woods homes are served by a community sanitary sewer system that could be damaged by flushing prohibited materials to the sewer. Only sanitary waste should be flushed down the drain.

The following are examples of **WHAT NOT TO FLUSH**:

- Diapers, feminine products (e.g., sanitary napkins, tampons), condoms, rags, or any kind of cloth, string or dental floss
- Gasoline, kerosene, solvents, paint thinner, paint, or any flammable or combustible materials
- Bulk grease or fat (cooking pans should be drained before cleaning; dispose of grease separately – do not rinse down the sink)
- Wipes of any kind (home cleaning, baby or personal hygiene)
- Sand, kitty litter, aquarium gravel, pet cage shavings
- Strong chemicals or toxic, caustic or poisonous substances

Plastic or metal objects

 Seafood shells, bones, cherry stones, peach pits, etc.

In the event that any damage is caused by any of the above, the cost to repair will be that of the homeowner.
