2018 Annual Report

This past year was largely uneventful for major issues with our sewer system. Most line items were within the allocated budget expense . The annual maintenance fee will remain at \$350 for July 1st 2018-thru June 30th 2019 . Our sewer system is entering its 8th year of operation. We will continue with the preventative maintenance contractor in order to monitor any changes in operating efficiencies.

Our concerns on controlling bioxide usage still exist as there is no way to predict the rate outgoing flow. I'd like to thank Will Szeszakow for constantly evaluating usage, pump starts, charting waste flow, & calculating weekly comparisons which help us better understand the usage fluctuations. A few board members will soon be visiting East Lyme's new computer based system to discuss if there might be a way for POW to reduce gallons usage by electronically metering the system.

I'd like to thank the WPCA Board members, Dick Hrinak, Bud Phelps, Ken Russell, Bill Griffin, alternate Will Szeszakow , treasurer Rita Sulick & secretary Bill Pape for their efforts handling various projects that are essential in maintaining a privately controlled sewer system. Our part time tech Rick Frascarelli and Tom Creten make themselves available at short notice to handle any issues that could effect the integrity of the system.
